
- 2.1.1 The Works Approval Holder shall submit a compliance document to the CEO, following the construction of the works and prior to commissioning of the same.

3 Executive summary of proposal and assessment

Paradise Beef Pty Ltd operates a beef cattle feedlot under Licence L8473/2010/1. The feedlot was established in 2010 with a capacity of 1,400 animals.

This works approval (W5125/2012/1) was issued in April 2012 for an extension of the existing infrastructure, to increase the design capacity to 2,600 animals. This amendment relates to an extension of the expiry date of this works approval, as works have not yet commenced and will not be completed prior to the current expiry.

As part of this amendment, the works approval has been updated to the current DER works approval format.
