The facility needs to maintain these records.

This is a requirement in order to verify the inventory of animals that are currently on hand at the facility.

CLEANING, SANITIZATION, HOUSEKEEPING, AND PEST CONTROL.

The refrigerator which stored the primate diet was observed to have a build up of grime. This area needs to be maintained in a sanitary manner. The Facility needs to clean areas where food is stored as frequently as possible in order to prevent a build up of grime and prevent contamination of the primate diet.

FACILITIES, OUTDOOR.

The pen for one of the raccoons had standing water and was extremely muddy. This created a condition where there was no dry area for the raccoon. This could potentially cause distress to the animal. Enclosures need to be maintained in a condition so as not to cause distress to the animal. The region had recently received a large amount of rain. The facility is currently in the process of renovating the pen and will be applying dirt and gravel in order to prevent a muddy condition.


